

OATHS AND DECLARATIONS ACT 1957

Statutory Declaration in Respect of a Stationary Vehicle Offence

I, of

solemnly and sincerely declare that:

1. I have received a notice as the owner, one of the owners, or a person lawfully entitled to possession of the vehicle which has allegedly been involved in a stationary vehicle offence;

I am the authorised representative of the following incorporated body who received notification of a stationary vehicle offence:

2. The vehicle allegedly involved in the stationary vehicle offence is

Note: This form must be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace, Solicitor, Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the High Court or District Court, Commissioned or Non-Commissioned Officer of Police, or other person authorised by the Minister of Justice to take a statutory declaration.

Under the Land Transport Act 1998 a person is liable on conviction to a penalty of \$10,000 for making any statement in a statutory declaration knowing that statement to be false or misleading in any material particular.
