BEE KEEPING

OK in urban areas if property larger than 700m².

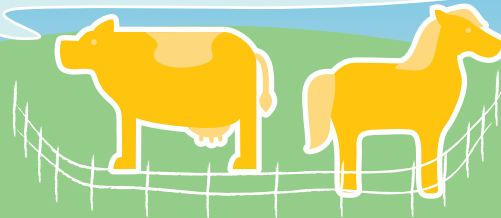
Up to 6 hives, depending on property size.



ANIMALS IN GENERAL

Make sure they don't cause a nuisance, damage property or affect public health and safety.

Other nuisance issues such as noise and drainage are regulated by other bylaws, our District Plan and government legislation.



SMOKE

Waikato Regional Council manages smoke issues.



CATS AND DOGS

Would not apply to cats and dogs.

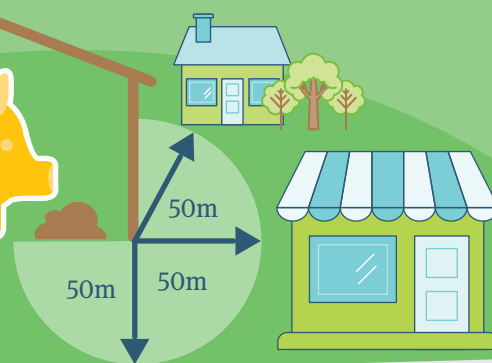

KEEPING PIGS

OK in urban areas.

Pigsties - at least 50m from any dwelling, occupied building, street, public place or anywhere food is stored, prepared or sold.



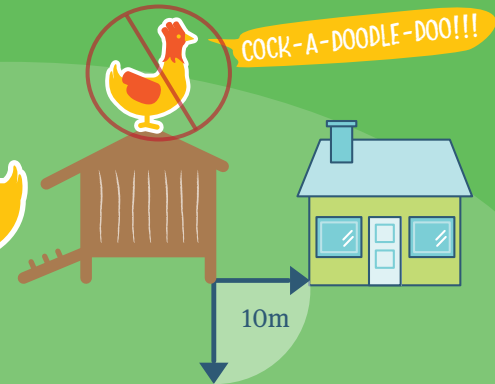
POULTRY

OK in urban areas

Up to 6 hens.

No roosters.

Hen house needed. Must be at least 10m from any building and 2m from adjoining properties.
