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Considering our proposed capital expenditure projects planned for 2020/2021, tell us about any projects that you want delayed, cancelled, added or changed.

All capital expenditure should be considered to be on hold for FY21. If unable to be fully delayed, projects should be prioritised over a minimum time frame of 3-5 years, such that essential work only is to be completed in the first instance.

What Council's services do you value the most?

Improvements to playgrounds should be halted, there are more than sufficient, nor is there overcrowding here in peak season. Tennis courts could also be reconsidered as there are a number of courts all within Pauanui currently free which have plenty of space even within peak seasons.

Do you have any suggestions for increasing revenue now or in the future?

Rate to be adjusted in line with CPI Inflation as opposed to one off hikes. Increasing the reserve contribution costs for people subdividing/developing sections with capital to contribute to the local community.

Tell us what you think about increasing user fees to better reflect the costs.

Council resources should be user pays so that people who are actively making use of the facilities contribute to the cost.

Do you have any further comments about fees and charges?

In light of the current economic environment, where there are significant costs incurred to the economy and households in general it would be more appropriate to spread these projects over a number of years to ease the rate increase cost for FY21 in the first instance.
