Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Variation of conditions requested: Alcohol may be sold and supplied pursuant to this Club Licence to a person who is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor as defined in the 2012 Act.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Thames-Coromandel District Licensing Committee at Thames-Coromandel District Council, 515 Mackay Street, Thames.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at 515 Mackay Street, Thames.

No objection to the variation of conditions of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 120 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
