



Notice of Day of Referendum Fluoridation of Thames Water Supply

Notice is given under sections 9 and 65 of the Local Electoral Act 2001, that on **Thursday 5 November 2015**, the Fluoridation of Thames Water Supply Referendum will be held under the First Past the Post electoral system by postal vote.

The referendum is to determine if fluoridation of the Thames water supply continues.

The outcome of the referendum will be binding on the Thames-Coromandel District Council.

Issuing of Voting Documents

Voting documents will be posted to electors within the Thames water supply area of service from Wednesday 14 October 2015.

Return of Voting Documents

Voting documents must be returned no later than 12 noon on Thursday 5 November 2015 to the Electoral Officer, Thames-Coromandel District Council.

Voting documents can be returned by mail or hand delivered to the Thames-Coromandel District Council office (515 Mackay Street, Thames) between Wednesday 14 October 2015 and Wednesday 4 November 2015 during normal office hours, and Thursday 5 November 2015 until 12 noon.

Special Voting

Special voting in terms Local Electoral Act 2001 and the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 may be exercised at the above-mentioned Council office, or by telephoning the Electoral Office on 0800 922 822.

A person may apply to enrol as either a residential or ratepayer elector right up to and including Wednesday 4 November 2015 - the day before the close of voting.
