# membership

## Free membership

It is free for those living both in and out of the Thames-Coromandel area to join the Thames, Mercury Bay and Tairua libraries. You only have to pay a small charge of \$2 for the library card.

## How to join

Just bring in your photo ID (passport, driver's license or other photo ID card) and a document confirming your home address (like a power bill or bank statement) and you'll be all ready to go.

## You can borrow:

Books, magazines, DVDs and talking books.

Books and talking books are issued for three weeks, while all other items are issued for one.

You can have up to 20 items on load at any time.

## Renewals

Items may be renewed for an additional issue period, providing they have not been requested by another borrower. Rental items incur another charge upon renewal.
