1. Formalise existing entrance to the park from Ti Kouka Cres.
2. Realign open drainage channel. Plant the riparian. Divert the stream slightly from a straight line to look more natural.
3. Boundary planted in a mix of native screen vegetation including *cordyline australis* and *phormium tenax*
4. Additional sitting logs in front of freedom camping and family parking area creating defined safe areas away from cars and trailers.
5. Boat and trailer parking area. Informal, no markings. Thresholds clearly sign posted to provide direction for cars and trailers. Existing wooden X to be removed from car park area so that it is not confused as a heli landing area.
6. New car park area for the water sports beach. Additional logs in front of carpark area to prevent cars driving onto the beach and to provide extra seating for watching water sports. Gaps left to provide easy access to walk through, carrying water sport equipment. The existing walkway that connects this area to the village centre has a consistent theme of natural play elements. These logs can double as natural play balance beams along the edge of the walkway.
7. A new toilet in the existing location will be upgraded including being connected to the council waste water system and potable water supply.
8. New informal car park area for family beach and playground. Access off the one way boat and trailer loop.
9. Water sport activity beach area (eg. kite surfing and jet skiing). Large lawn area allows for set up of equipment, as well as sand area suitable for launching. Gap big enough for a car left on the eastern side of car park for a car and small trailer able to launch jet skis from the beach.
10. Old pine trees removed to allow beach to transition back into natural beach area, since the removal of seawall.
11. Realign coastal walkway path once trees are removed to accommodate family beach area, accounting for the area that will erode back into the beach area.
12. Family area, including play and future fitness equipment, picnic tables and seating areas. Picnic tables placed underneath new shade trees overlooking the reformed family beach area.
13. Relocated family beach area to be near playground.
14. Low planting to allow visual lines to toilet area but direct pedestrian movement to clear pathways to minimize the areas that people can cross vehicles paths.
